HOW MUCH DOES IT COST TO RUN THE CHURCH???

Great question!! The information below will help spotlight the financial picture of Grace United Methodist Church according to the 2021 financial report.

IN 2021...

- \$104,233 | expenses for FACILITY (maintenance, utilities, building services, and insurance). FACILITY includes the church building, church grounds, 2 garages, 2 parsonages and the church van
- \$16,478 | expenses for SUPPLIES (office supplies, kitchen supplies, cleaning supplies, postage, & office equipment)
- \$60,519 | expenses for CHILDREN & YOUTH MINISTRY (Raggedy Ann Preschool expenses, Raggedy Ann Preschool teacher salaries, Children and Youth Ministry staff salaries, Children and Youth Ministry program expenses)
- \$112,905 | expenses for PASTORAL SERVICES (Senior Pastor salary, Associate Pastor salary, Director of Congregational Care salary, and professional expenses)
- \$32,889 | expenses for WORSHIP (Music staff salaries, Wedding expenses, Guest Preacher fees, worship supplies, music supplies)
- \$86,169 | expenses for ADMINISTRATIVE AND BUILDING STAFF (Salaries)
- \$11,925 | expenses for ANNUAL CONFERENCE AND DISTRICT TITHE

\$62,856 | expenses for EMPLOYMENT (Pension, insurance, FICA and Health Reimbursement)

The above expenses are Operating Expenses, which are paid from the OPERATING FUND. The income from the Operating Fund comes from any donation given to the church (that does not have a specified designation). Giving to the Operating Fund goes directly to maintaining the facilities, paying staff, and funding ministry programs.

WHAT ABOUT INCOME TO COVER THE OPERATING EXPENSES?

Another great question!

IN 2021... \$463,750 | Total Income given to the OPERATING FUND \$32,741 | Total Income from RAGGEDY ANN PRESCHOOL \$11,016 | OTHER Income \$511 | INTEREST Income \$508,018 | TOTAL Income given for the operation of the church
