Our Lenten Journey will start with an Ash Wednesday worship service in our sanctuary on Wednesday, February 22 at 7PM. I hope you are able to join us for that. Then, we'll focus on a particular story each Sunday through Lent. A preview of the sermons and weekly devotional themes are listed on the next page.

I am looking forward to all of the ways God will speak to us through these sermons and the devotionals throughout the Lenten Season. I hope you are too. My prayer for all of us is that we will be open to the Holy Spirit's guidance as we journey through this season, knowing Jesus more, growing closer to him, and going out into the world to share his love with others. In the coming weeks we will share more information about the devotionals and our Holy Week and Easter plans.
