
laughter, and worship that will forever be etched in my heart.

BIBLE STUDY BEGINS SEPTEMBER 19

LED BY PASTOR JIM


In <u>Making Sense of the Bible</u>, Adam Hamilton invites us into an honest conversation about the Bible. The book begins with foundational questions such as:

- How and when was the Bible written?
- Who decided which books made it into the scriptures and why?
- How literally must we read it? And, is the Bible ever wrong?

From there, Hamilton considers the real questions people frequently ask that continue to divide Christians and denominations alike, including:

- Were Adam and Eve real people?
- Why is God so violent in the Old Testament?
- Why would Paul command women to keep silent in the church?
- Is Jesus the only way to salvation?
- How does God view homosexual people?
- Is the Book of Revelation a guide to the End Times

In approachable and inviting language, Hamilton addresses these often misunderstood biblical themes leading listeners to a deeper appreciation of the Bible so that we might hear God speak through it and find its words to be life-changing and life-giving. STUDY OF JOHN

BIBLE STUDY FELLOWSHIP

Bible Study Fellowship is an in-depth Bible study that meets mid-September - early May (with a long break in December). This fall, BSF groups around the world will begin a study of the gospel according to John. Classes meet weekly and follow a four-part format for each week's lesson: personal study at home, small-group discussion and an all-class lecture at a local church, followed by commentary notes to read at home.

Locally, there are both men's groups and women's groups, and some include children's programs. (Daytime groups include a program for infants through pre-school; evening groups include a K-12 program.) BSF offers inperson and virtual options.
