Sacred Rhythms for Lent and Beyond

The focus at Grace UMC this Lenten Season will be Spiritual Transformation. Traditionally the Season of Lent has been at time in the life of the Church, and more specifically in the life of individual followers of Jesus, to intentionally draw closer to God. It could be said that Lent is our time to prepare ourselves to celebrate the resurrection on Easter Sunday, and then to live our lives for the rest of the year drawing closer and closer to God through Christ.

The six Sundays of Lent at Grace UMC will include messages, liturgy and music aimed at helping us learn spiritual practices that can help us know and experience God more in our individual lives. Throughout the season I'll often refer to a book called Sacred Rhythms by Ruth Haley Barton. The individual practices we'll focus on come from this book. I want to encourage you to consider purchasing the book for yourself as a way to dive even deeper into the spiritual practices within. The book can be purchased on Amazon.

- 3.17.24 | SELF-EXAMINATION: Bringing My Whole Self Before God
- 3.24.24 | SABBATH: Establishing Rhythms of Work and Rest

In addition to the opportunities for spiritual transformation on Sunday mornings during Lent, you are also invited to participate in "From the Inside Out," a spiritual formation workshop that will be led by our own Joe Venema on Tuesday evenings from 6-7:30PM beginning February 13. I am praying for spiritual transformation for all of us during this Lenten Season. I am praying we will all find ways to draw closer to God through these practices. “FROM THE INSIDE OUT” A WORKSHOP ON CHRISTIAN SPIRITUAL FORMATION

If you are an ordinary Christian who is looking for “something more” in your spiritual life, this workshop may be for you. Jesus tells us that He came so we might have life, abundant life, here and now, a life filled with faith, hope, love, joy, and peace.

He says that this abundant life, here and now, can only be ours if we abide in Him. Abiding in Him means developing a close, personal, and ongoing relationship with Him. Our personal relationship with Him is His primary method of transforming our life into the abundant life he promises.

“Jesus-centered spiritual formation is the process of being transformed into the image of Christ, through a relationship of intimacy with God, by the power of the Spirit, in order to live a beautiful life of faith, hope, love, joy and peace, a life that will be a blessing to oneself and to others and will glorify God now, and for all eternity.” James Brian Smith

“From the Inside Out” is an introductory course about how to intentionally form a closer friendship with Christ. It was developed by Renovare, a Christian organization, whose mission is to help people become more like Jesus. (cf. renovare.com). Joe Venema has offered to facilitate the sessions at Grace. Joe, a member at Grace, is a retired psychologist with graduate degrees in theology and psychology. He has been a teacher and retreat leader for many years at churches in Southern California where he lived before coming to South Bend.

“From the Inside Out” will be offered on six consecutive Tuesday evenings from 6PM to 7:30PM beginning February 13, 2024. All course materials will be provided free of charge. While this will be a group class, there is no expectation or requirement that you will share personal information with others in the class. Any sharing will be voluntary.

We have seen several changes in our church over the past year. Some of the changes are obvious to our members, such as the arrival of Pastor Jim Clark and his family. The Finance Committee, along with the other leadership teams and ministry leaders spent time last fall putting together a budget for the 2024 church year. As we looked back on 2023, we did our best to be realistic about the needs of the church and its mission within our community. Like a lot of households now, our expenses outweigh our income. In response to that discovery we have been working diligently to reduce our

expenses. You will see a few more changes as we do this. An email from Pastor Jim a few weeks ago detailed one major change, the combining of three program areas into one staff position. Other smaller changes have been made that will not be noticeable except when it comes to paying the bills. Our leadership teams and staff are brainstorming ways they can be most responsible and effective as we continue to be the church in our community.

Once the budget is finalized, copies will be available in the office for anyone who would like to see it. You only need to stop in and ask for a copy. Another change that you will see will be in the Newsletter. Each month, starting in February, there will be a short note on the finances of

the church for the previous month. Without going into too much detail, we will share the income and expenses of the church for that month and year-to-date. The Finance Committee is committed to being transparent so everyone can know what our financial picture looks like.

Grace UMC is a vital part of the South Bend and Mishawaka communities. We are doing good ministry and finding ways to love our neighbors as we love ourselves. We are only able to do that because of the generosity of people like you. Thank you for being generous! And Thank you for being the Church!
